Also known as potable water

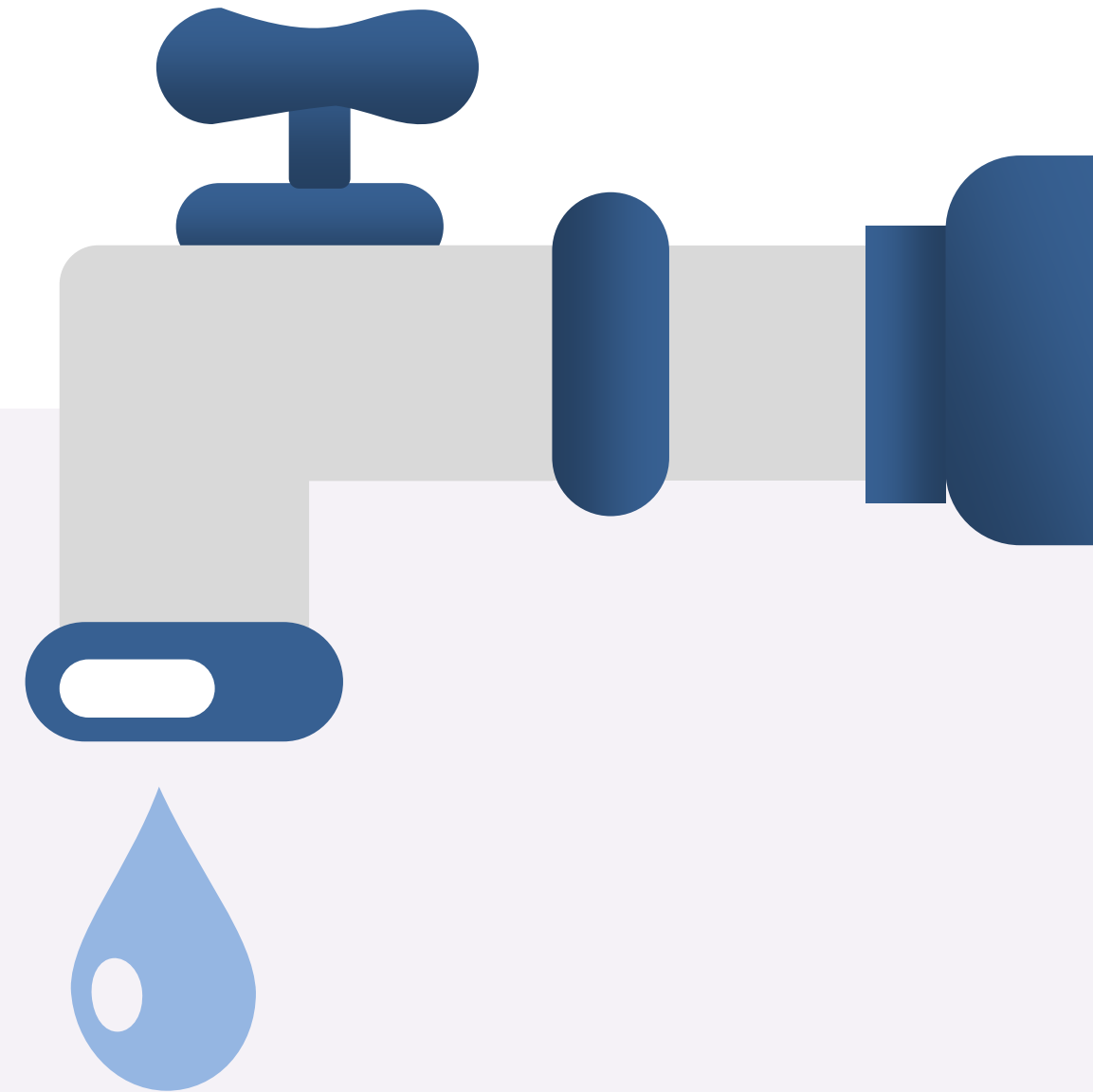


Wastewater

The data behind the utility :

- PBCWUD is the 3rd largest full -service utility in Florida
- Serves + 630,000 residents
- Employees +600 employees
- Owns and operates 9 water, wastewater, reclaimed water plants
- Over +4,000 miles of pipes
- Maintains +1,000 lift stations

WAREHOUSE OPERATIONS

- WUD Operates 3 Regional Warehouses
 - CROC –West Palm Beach – 20,000 SQF
 - Materials Manager, 3 Storekeepers, 1 GMM (Tool Room)
 - SROC – Delray Beach – 20,000 SQF
 - Materials Manager, 2 Storekeepers, 1 GMM (Tool Room)
 - WROC – Belle Glade – 7,000 SQF
 - Materials Manager, 1 Storekeeper

PROCUREMENT

- Government Purchasing in a nutshell
- Palm Beach County: Centralized Purchasing
 - County Purchasing is responsible for the acquisition of non construction goods and services for all departments.
 - WUD has Construction Authority delegated by the Purchasing Director. Enables WUD to contract for construction related activities.
- Driven by the County's Procurement Code
- Primary Purpose of Government Purchasing is to provide an open competitive process for the acquisition of goods and services.

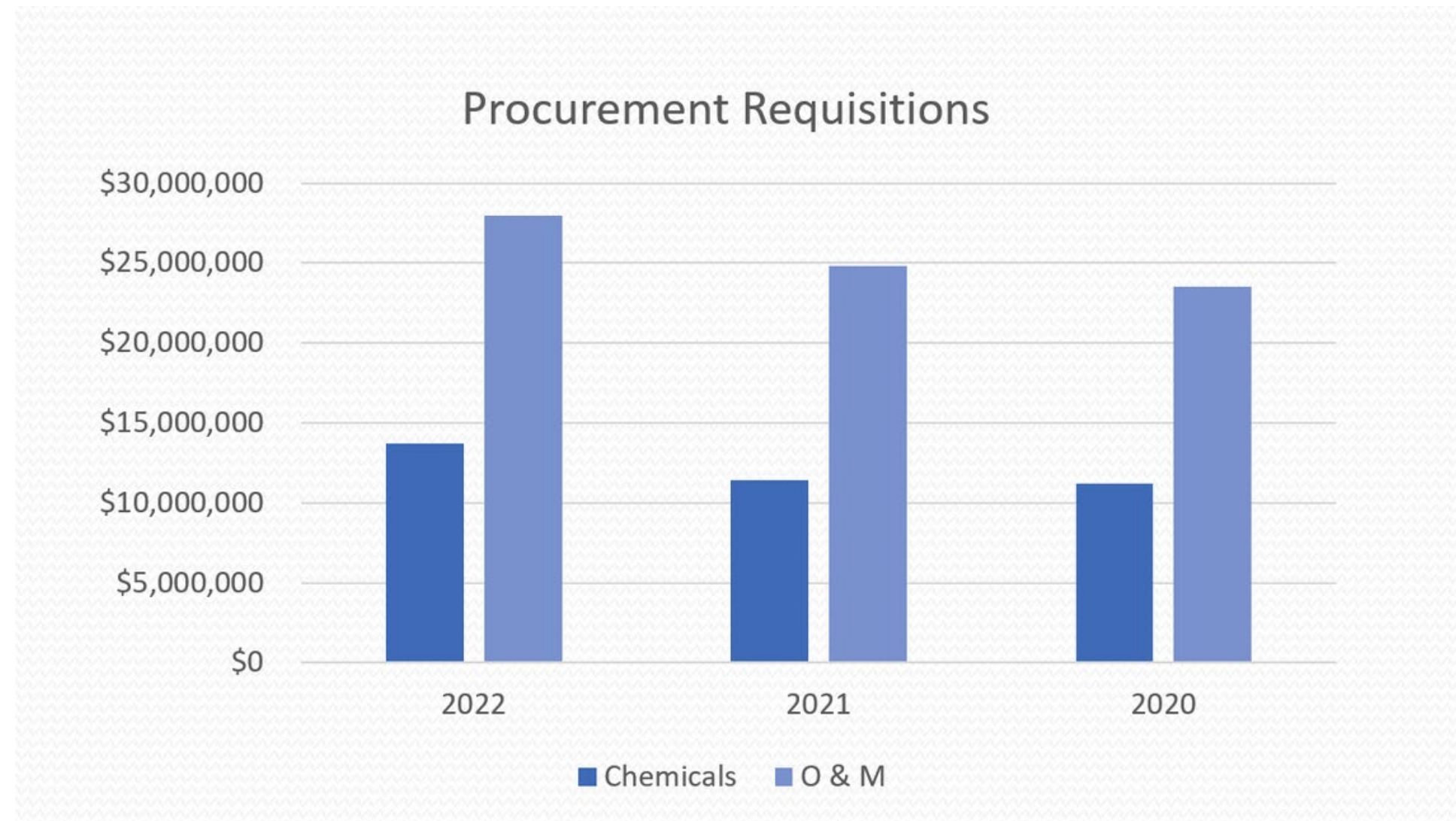
PBCWUD Procurement Overview

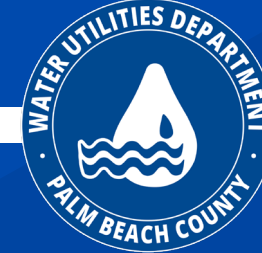
