


FS# 49 - Project History

- Planning began in 2018 during regulatory review of the Master Plan for the Monticello AGR PUD, which generated a 5.57-acre civic land use obligation; 2.73 acres of which were committed for a fire station and conveyed to PBC in September 2020.
- First included in the County's Capital Improvements Program in FY2020, at the time known as "Agricultural Reserve Central Fire Station", with an appropriation of \$1.1M from Impact Fees. A subsequent \$5.1M ad valorem appropriation was included in the FY2021 CIP, with an additional \$3M ad valorem and \$1M Impact Fee appropriations in the FY2023 CIP, for a combined total of \$10.2M to date. Future appropriations of \$3.9M are anticipated, for a cumulative amount of \$14.1M.
- Description: This project involves the construction of a new permanent three-bay station to serve the expansion of the central part of the Agricultural Reserve. The primary users of this facility will be the firefighters and paramedics assigned to this station.


FS# 49 - Scope

- On April 5, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners approved a Consultant Services Authorization with Currie Sowards Aguila Architects, Inc. to provide design, bidding, permitting assistance and construction administration services for FS #49.

 - ~18,000 sq. ft.
 - 4 bays, 15 bunk rooms
 - Generator room
 - Diesel dispenser
 - Site improvements
 - Emergency signalization





- Opening: Spring 2025


FS# 49 - Immediate Initiative

- On January 20, 2022, FDO issued a Consultant Services Authorization to Currie Sowards Aguila Architects, Inc. to provide design and engineering services to permit a temporary trailer to commence FS #49 services to the area.
- Single story modular/portable structure
 - ~1,000 sq. ft.
 - 3 sleeping spaces
 - 2 full baths
 - Kitchen/Living Room
 - Utility connections
 - Aluminum apparatus canopy
 - Site improvements
