VICTIM INDICATORS

- Appears fearful, anxious, depressed, intimidated, submissive, tense, nervous, or paranoid
- Avoids eye contact or lacks emotional responsiveness
- Is accompanied by a group or a controlling friend or boyfriend who speaks for them

- Shows signs of physical abuse such as bruises, scratches, scars, missing teeth, lacerations, burns, carvings
- May be dressed inappropriately for the weather or venue
- Is living or working in a location with excessive security measures

Is under 18 and may be performing commercial sex acts

TRAFFICKER INDICATORS

- Controls victim movement and conversation
- Offers a generous tip for your cooperation
- Asks driver to wait outside the hotel, apartment or business

- Drops off several men, women or children in one or different locations
- Drops off same person at different locations day or night (hotels, motels, spas, massage parlors, apartment complexes)

- Asks to be dropped off in the back or separate proppedopen entrance
- At drop off, transfers people into the possession of another person to escort them inside the establishment
